<b>Jacket</b> (Ship's Company Pattern – self sourced)	Dark blue wool, to pattern. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Standing collar.</li> <li>• Outside pockets.</li> <li>• Lined or unlined.</li> <li>• 3 Working buttons on cuffs.</li> <li>• Two rows of nine (9) large buttons on breast. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Yellow metal Navy eagle button, <u>or</u> plain brass</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	Dark blue wool <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• With or without standing collar</li> <li>• Brass, white metal or dark buttons (5 to 9)</li> </ul> White Fustian fatigue jacket <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To pattern</li> </ul>
<b>Hat</b> (Matthew Brenckle)	Black wool, round or common hat. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Same as civilian.</li> <li>• Narrow black ribbon.</li> </ul>	Black wool round hat <u>or</u> Straw sennit round hat <u>or</u> Knit cap (Monmouth pattern)
<b>Neck Handkerchief or “kerchief”</b>	Black silk <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• At least 36inch square</li> </ul>	Black Silk
<b>Trousers</b> (Smoke & Fire Sutler)	White duck. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Full leg</li> <li>• Narrow fall</li> </ul>	Blue wool <u>or</u> White duck <u>or</u> White canvas <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Full leg</li> <li>• Fall front</li> </ul>
<b>Suspenders</b>	Undyed linen	Undyed linen
<b>Shoes</b> (Jarnigan)	Black leather, low counter. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Laced or buckled.</li> </ul>	Black leather, low counter. Laced or buckled.
<b>Socks</b>	Plain, wool or cotton	Plain, wool or cotton
<b>Shirt</b>	To pattern. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wide collar.</li> <li>• Plain White <u>or</u></li> <li>• Blue/White check</li> </ul>	To pattern – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Plain white <u>or</u></li> <li>• Check, any primary, natural dye color</li> </ul>
<b>Vest</b>	Red wool – 1812 military pattern. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Standing collar.</li> <li>• Single row of small yellow metal buttons.</li> </ul>	Red Wool <u>or</u> White Linen w/ white metal or white bone/shell buttons
